What is IBCP?

IBCP stands for the International Baccalaureate Career-related Programme. It is an internationally recognised qualification for students aged 16–19.

The programme integrates three elements

1

Academic Study

IB Diploma subjects for depth

2

Career Study

Practical, career-focused learning

3

IBCP Core

Skills framework and personal development

Unlike traditional boards that focus mainly on exams, IBCP combines academic depth with practical application.

It is suitable for students who:

- Show early interest in a career pathway
- Prefer learning by doing
- Want global exposure
- Aspire to study in India or abroad

It is also suitable for students who are still exploring — but want structured direction



Academic Strength: IB Diploma Subjects

The IBCP mandates a minimum of **two IB Diploma Programme (DP) subjects**, providing strong academic grounding alongside career-focused learning. These subjects are externally assessed by IB examiners worldwide (grades 1-7).

- **Conceptual Depth**
Goes beyond memorisation, fostering true understanding.
- **Critical Thinking**
Emphasises analysis and problem-solving
- **Experiential Learning**
Practical application brings theoretical concepts to life.
- **International Benchmarking**

What is the IBCP Core?



The **IBCP Core** is what truly differentiates the programme, acting as the bridge where academic learning transforms into real-world capability. While students immerse themselves in IB subjects and pursue their chosen career pathway, the Core ensures they also cultivate the essential skills, maturity, and mindset required for life beyond school.

The Core Consists of Four Components:

01

Reflective Project

An independent, in-depth research project where students investigate an ethical issue connected to their chosen career field, fostering critical thinking and research skills.

03

Community Engagement

Students apply their academic knowledge and developing skills to meaningful community engagement, cultivating a sense of social responsibility and practical application.

02

Personal & Professional Skills (PPS)

This course specifically develops the competencies students need to succeed in higher education and the workplace, focusing on communication, collaboration, and problem-solving.

04

Language & Cultural Studies

Students continue developing a second language, enhancing their intercultural understanding and global communication abilities, vital in today's interconnected world.

04


Reflective Project
